

# *Junior NCE: Cycle of Additional Activities*

## Teacher's Book 1

This is a (simplified) overview of the cycle of Rhymes and Songs, Games and Dictations through Book 1. These activities are not mentioned on the SB pages. **Note:** Sometimes, the first Lesson in each Unit (of **Book 3**) end with a Rhyme or a Song (a lot repeated), and the second Lesson in each Unit end with a Game (again, some repeated) or a Dictation. However, as much of the language and the activities in level 3 are much more extensive than in Levels 1 and 2, and the Dictation is often combined with a Listening or Pronunciation exercise, so the pattern of extra activities in Level 3 is more fluid.
